

MCCTC Chromebook Use & Purchase Agreement

Directions: Please review each element of the agreement below. Chromebooks are distributed by the school to each student upon purchase by the parent and will be used as a digital learning tool. A parent and student signature is required below.

I understand and agree to abide by the following:

1. Mahoning County CTC is issuing me a Chromebook for use in teaching and learning purposes. Upon payment, I am the owner of the Chromebook.
2. Student will bring the Chromebook to school daily with the battery fully charged.
3. Student will transport their Chromebook to and from school in a protective sleeve or case and will store the Chromebook in a secure location when not in use.
4. Student will be responsible for the appropriateness of content accessed and/or stored on the Chromebook.
5. Student will not allow anyone else to use their Google Account to log into the App store, Chrome store, or another app that requires a Google account on my Chromebook.
6. Damage to the Chromebook will be your responsibility. There is a 1-year depot warranty. This does not cover accidental damage. Theft and/or damage to the Chromebook should be reported immediately to MCCTC personnel.
7. Student will use the Chromebook during the school day for school related purposes only. Devices will be monitored in our filtering server.
8. A "loaner" Chromebook will be issued to the student when IT personnel have taken possession of the Chromebook for repairs or have determined the damage to be accidental in nature.
9. The purchase price of the Chromebook is \$100, which includes the Chromebook and charging cable. The replacement cost of the Chromebook if the warranty does not apply is \$150.
10. Student will need to purchase their own carrying case/sleeve for the Chromebook.

I understand and agree to abide by the usage requirement listed above. I agree to assume responsibility for damage or theft to this equipment while in my possession. I understand that violations of this agreement may result in disciplinary action, the revoking of technology access, and/or appropriate legal action.
