Boardman Rotary Scholarship

Requirements:

The following requirement will be strictly enforced. If the student-scholar does not meet all eight requirements, he/she will be disqualified from meeting with us for an interview. These requirements are:

1. Applicant must be a high school senior.
2. Applicant must be planning to attend an accredited college or university
4. Applicant must be able to provide proof of financial need.
5. Applicant must attach The Boardman Rotary Club Scholarship Application.
6. Applicant must attach an official high school transcript.
7. Applicant must attach two letters of personal reference.
8. Applicant must attach a 125 word paper detailing their service to others.

Selection Procedures:

1. The Rotary Club of Boardman is the sponsoring organization and the award is the responsibility of the Board of Directors of The Rotary Club of Boardman.
2. After having met with Student Applicants, the selection will be made by the Rotary Club of Boardman interviewers on the day of the interviews.
3. The Scholarship payment will be payable directly to the college or university upon proof of enrollment.
4. The scholarship will be presented at the senior awards assembly.
5. All programs and activities of the Boardman Rotary are available to all on a nondiscriminatory basis without regard to race, color, national origin, sex, handicap, or religious affiliation.
6. The Rotary Club of Boardman is a non-profit organization.
