Requirements:

1. Applicant must be planning to attend Youngstown State University. Acceptance letter from the school must be attached.
2. Applicant must be a current senior at Mahoning County Career and Technical Center.
3. Student must have a 3.2 or higher GPA.
4. Applicant must attach an official high school transcript.
5. Applicant must attach one letter of personal reference.
6. Applicant must attach a 150-300 word essay detailing how this scholarship would benefit them in furthering their education.

Procedures:

1. The selection will be made the family of J. Paul Good in consultation with appropriate personnel of the Mahoning County Career and Technical Center.
2. The Scholarship payment will be payable directly to Youngstown State University.
3. The scholarship will be presented at the Senior Awards Assembly.
