

Information About Stambaugh Auditorium
MCCTC Senior Awards Ceremony
May 31, 2019

The following information is being provided so that you and our graduating seniors are aware of the standard procedures of Stambaugh Auditorium. We at MCCTC have worked closely with the officials of Stambaugh Auditorium to ensure a dignified Senior Awards Ceremony that is enjoyable and memorable for all in attendance.

Doors Open: 8:00 a.m. No guests will be admitted into the auditorium before that time. All visitors will be permitted to arrive and be seated up to 8:55. At that time no one will be permitted to enter the auditorium until AFTER the graduates are seated. All visitors must enter from the Fifth Avenue entrance. Designated handicapped entrances are available. All students will report to the Ballroom to prepare for the ceremony. No family or guests will be permitted in that area before or after the ceremony.

Parking: There is available parking on site. Additional parking is allowed on both Park and Fifth Avenues, as well as additional overflow lots near the auditorium. Security will be on hand to both assist and direct guests. All public parking is free.

Seating: Stambaugh Auditorium, although a public venue, does not have unlimited seating. So that all graduates can have family present, we ask that no more than six family members/friends attend. All visitors need to remain seated until the students have proceeded out. No one will be permitted to exit into the lobby before the new graduates.

Handicapped Seating: Seating for handicapped individuals is very limited and is available to those individuals **ONLY**. One, and only one, other guest will be permitted to sit in a Companion Seat in the row located immediately behind. Stambaugh Auditorium staff members will be on hand to direct all other accompanying members to the general seating areas if necessary.

Photos: There will be a designated area with the MCCTC logo in the first floor main lobby for photos AFTER the ceremony. Photos can also be taken outside of the Auditorium at that time, weather permitting. There will also be a professional photographer on site taking pictures of each of the graduates as they receive their Career Passports. Those photos will be available for purchase.

Restrictions: At the discretion of Stambaugh staff, visitors may be required to return any unusually large or suspicious bags to their vehicles. Also, helium balloons are prohibited anywhere inside of the auditorium before, during, or after the ceremony.
