## MCCTC 2020 Senior Celebration/Outdoor Guidelines

- → All social distancing, BOH, and RestartOhio guidelines will be strictly enforced and are non-negotiable for ALL in attendance.
- → If you, or anyone in your family, has been exposed to or suffered from Covid 19 14 days prior to the ceremony you may not attend. All senior materials will be mailed.
- → Attendance is not mandatory for any participants (students and parents) and is open to only those comfortable with government guidelines as outlined below.
- → Seniors are allowed ONE guest vehicle containing family/friends) in the lot (no riders in the back of a pick up truck and all vehicles must be able to fit in a single parking space.)
- → Graduates should plan on arriving in the above vehicle which will be led to the designated door of their procession. If a graduate must arrive separately he/she is not permitted to have guests accompanying them. Those students will be directed to the "graduate lot" from which the ceremonies will not be visible. THERE WILL BE NO ADDITIONAL INDIVIDUAL SEATING AREA.
- → Additional vehicles will not be permitted to enter campus
- → Seniors may decorate their cars in compliance with the Student Code of Conduct.
- → Only one academy on campus at any one time in accordance with the assigned. schedule.. Seniors may not enter or remain on campus to observe another academy.
- → Seniors will only be granted entrance to the parking lot 30 minutes before their academy's scheduled time. There will be only one entrance and exit.
- → All seniors must arrive dressed in their cap and gown.
- → Upon arrival, seniors will be issued the contents of their Career Passports, MCCTC tassel and, if applicable, a STEM cord.
- → On campus, masks are mandatory for ALL.
- → A JumboTron and link to a radio station will assist guests in viewing and hearing from all vehicles; the ceremony will also be available on YouTube for anyone who cannot attend
- → Outdoor venue; only those students participating will be permitted into the "D" hallway where staff will assist the lineup for the procession. Students will not be permitted back into the building after the ceremony.
- → Family members must remain in the vehicle at ALL times.
- → No student will be permitted to walk without a face mask.
- → Vehicles will be parked in staggered spaces/rows that correspond with the Student #.
- → Seniors arriving late will be guided to a reserved area so there is no interruption to the ceremony.
- → During the procession and throughout the ceremony, social distancing guidelines will be practiced.
- → Seniors will approach the stage from left and exit from the right.
- → Seniors will walk across the stage to receive their Passport binder.
- → After leaving the stage, seniors may proceed to the designated area for photos taken by our professional photographer. Students will be notified as to when they can pick up their photos at the Career Center.
- → After all seniors have received their Passport, the group will turn their tassels and be dismissed via police escort.
