

LOOKING FOR TUITION ASSISTANCE?

The Mahoning and Columbiana Training Association (MCTA) may be able to help with up to \$9,500/year for up to two years of non-loan assistance. You don't have to pay it back!

In order to be considered for tuition assistance, the following steps must be completed. It is your responsibility to fulfill these requirements before funding can occur.

Many of these steps occur during the same appointment or can be done from home. Don't be intimidated! Please keep reading!

HAVE YOU:

- Visited or contacted OhioMeansJobs Columbiana County or Mahoning County
- Registered in OhioMeansJobs.com and completed: **Career Profile**
- Completed the Career Exploration Workshop
- Completed Intake with a MIS Specialist
- Researched the program you are interested in (i.e. visit the school(s), speak to school personnel, review textbooks if available, etc.) **Program must be on the WIET list. Access this list online at <https://owcms.ohio.gov/wiet>**
- Applied to and been accepted into the school / program
- Completed the FAFSA application – <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/>
- Met with a Career Consultant to develop your Individual Employment Plan
- Completed aptitude and vocational interest assessments
- Shared your curriculum and/or transcript and a cost of attendance with your Career Consultant
