

Veteran Benefits and Transitions Act of 2018

The Mahoning County Career & Technical Center in accordance with the Veterans Benefits and Transition Act of 2018 will not impose any penalty, including the assessment of late fees, the denial of access to classes, libraries or other institutional facilities, or the requirement that a Chapter 31 or Chapter 33 recipient borrow additional funds to cover the individual's inability to meet his or her financial obligations to the institution due to the delayed disbursement of a payment by the U.S. Department of Veteran Affairs. This policy is limited to tuition funds paid by the U.S.

Department of Veteran Affairs.

Veteran Affairs: Isakson and Roe Section 1018

In compliance with Isakson and Roe Section 1018 and the Principles of Excellence, found in Executive Order 13607, MCCTC will allow service members and reservists to be readmitted to a program if they are temporarily unable to attend class or have to suspend their studies due to service requirements, and take additional steps to accommodate short absences due to service obligations, provided that satisfactory academic progress is being made by the service members and reservists prior to suspending their studies.
