WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Turn on the Newline Screen
- 2. Once the screen turns on, click anywhere on the screen to start.
- 3. To view your computer screen, click "VGA"



*From here you can interact with what is on your computer screen, using the smart display.



WHITEBOARD

- 1. To use it as a <u>Whiteboard</u>, click on that option
 - a. There will be a toolbar on the bottom of the screen to use both pen/drawing tools and keyboard
 - b. To save your work you will need to click on the pages symbol in the bottom right corner of the screen.
 - i. Click and hold on the picture/drawing you would like to save.
 - ii. Click Share
 - iii. Click "Save with FC". When your save options come up, select "Add cloud account". From here you can select to save it to your Google Drive, DropBox, or One Drive account.

You will need to add your account the first time you save an image, but after that you will be able to just click on you account to save it.





SCREEN SHARE

1. To <u>Screen Share</u>, on the Home Page, click on the Screen Sharing button.



2. From here, it will bring you to the following screen.
