Treatment Plant Aide assists with the operation of water distribution system and maintenance of wastewater treatment plant facilities. Responsible to assist with water and wastewater and sewage plant operations which include, but are not limited to: backwashing filters; regenerate softeners; set blow-down controls; clean diffuses, comminutors, trickling filters and bar screens; adjust air flow and raw water flow; disinfection; solid handling; maintain lagoons; and reading water meters. Responsible to perform daily chemical tests on water and sewage plant effluent to include: alkalinity, PH, dissolved oxygen and turbidity. Monitor and assist with the installation of piping, valve stems, belts and fittings. Set up, collect and deliver water samples on a daily basis; send samples to the state lab for analysis.
